What?

When?

Where?

In the playing field behind Woodborough Village Hall (by Lingwood Lane, the road to Lambley from Woodborough). Toilet facilities will be available at the cricket pavilion. If it rains heavily, the Village Hall will provide shelter.

Parents/Guardians please note:

This scheme has been organised by the Community Development Officer at Gedling Borough Council who will be providing a fully qualified sports coach for each age group. All sports coaches are fully enhanced CRB checked by Gedling Borough Council. A parent/guardian will need to be present at the beginning of the first session the child/children attends, to fill out contact and medical consent forms. Parents must drop off/collect their child/children, give permission for their child/children to leave on their own or have identified another relation to collect their child/children at the end of the session.
